Pulse Oximeter – estimated cost \$600 to \$2500. It would help determine the need for an ambulance verses private ride to hospital in respiratory emergencies. It would also help us monitor an asthmatic on site with use of inhalers as treatment. It would also be beneficial in monitoring allergic reactions to bee stings to catch if an anaphylactic reaction was developing that would require stronger medication than Benedryl currently being used on site			\$2,500.00	
Polaris Ranger – this would be a wonderful thing to obtain so the health officer has a Vehicle that can get to sites quickly, not be so big traveling through camp to pass meds and help in emergency situations and not have to use there personal vehicle. And save mileage gas and wear and tear on there own car at their expense.
