Sunday, March 29, 2009	Official Twin Valley Council Jamboree Kick-Off Meeting, starting at 3pm at the American Legion in Wells, MN.
February 2009 through April 2010	Scout applications received, approved, and payments made.
September 2009 to April 2010	Selection of Youth Leaders. Adult Leader planning sessions. Orientation session(s) for Scouts and Parents.
May or June 2010	Mandatory Prejamboree Training Session (Friday night-Sunday morning).
July 17, 2010	Depart by bus for the Jamboree
July 20-21, 2010	Arrive in the Washington, DC area
July 21-25, 2010	Travel and touring in Washington, DC
