

2020 Camp Fees

Scouts could have saved up to 22% of their cost of camp by selling Popcorn! Any Scout that sold over \$1,700 in popcorn received a \$25 discount on camp. If that Scout was in a unit that had an average sale of \$375 per boy, they earn an additional \$35 savings.

- **Super Saver** **\$235** Only Twin Valley Council units qualify for this level.
 - Payment must be received by May 1, 2020.
 - A \$20 refundable (Until May 1, 2020) deposit will be due by March 1, 2020.
 - Unit averages \$375/boy during 2019 popcorn sale based on # youth registered on 7/31/2019.
 - **Scouts and leaders receive a free camp t-shirt and patch.**
- **Early Bird** **\$270**
 - Payment received by May 1, 2020.
 - A \$20 refundable (Until May 1, 2020) deposit will be due by March 1, 2020.
 - Scout and leaders receive a free patch.
 - *Scouts and leaders can pre-order a t-shirt for only \$10.00.*
 - New Arrow of Light Scouts crossing over in Winter/Spring 2020 will qualify for this rate.
- **Regular** **\$300**
 - Payments received after May 1, 2020.
 - A \$20 refundable (Until May 1, 2020) deposit will be due by March 1, 2020.
 - Scouts and leaders will receive a free patch.
 - *T-shirts can be purchased in the trading post, if available, while supplies last for \$15.00. (Orders will NOT be taken at camp)*
- **2nd Week** **\$145**
 - Scouts attending a second full week of camp at Cuyuna.
 - Must be registered and paid by May 1, 2020 to qualify.
 - A \$20 refundable (Until May 1, 2020) deposit will be due by March 1, 2020.
- **Leaders** **\$120 for all Week** or **\$35/day**
 - Additional \$10 for part-time leaders if participating in steak fry on Thursday.
- **Campsite Reservation Fee** **\$100**
 - Refundable up to March 1, 2020.
 - 2021 Campsite reservations will open June 22, 2020, for Twin Valley Council troops and for out of council troops camping at Cuyuna in 2020 and August 15 for all out of council troops not camping at Cuyuna in 2020.



• **Refund Policy:**

No refunds after May 1, 2020, deadline except in a limited number of circumstances where a partial refund may be granted. All refunds are at the council's discretion. Fees are transferable to another Scout in your unit that is replacing the youth no longer able to attend.

- A **partial refund** may be granted if the registered participant has an illness preventing participation in the event and has a signed statement from a medical doctor or healthcare practitioner. The written statement from the doctor and a written request for a refund must be provided to the council within 7 days of the camp. – Up to a 75% refund
- A **partial refund** may be granted in the event of the death of an immediate family member. The council will consider any other death, which may affect the participant, on a case by case basis. A written request for a refund must be provided to the council within 7 days of the event. – Up to a 75% refund
- A **partial refund** may be granted if the participant needs to attend summer school and those dates conflict with the event. A note from the school is required along with a written request for a refund within 7 days of the event. – Up to a 50% refund
